The International Real Estate Valuation Conference 2014 was held on 23 to 24 October in Beijing. The Conference was hosted by the China Institute of Real Estate Appraisers and Agents (CIREA), the World Association of Valuation Organizations, the Singapore Institute of Surveyors and Valuers and the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors. I attended the conference with HKIS representatives and introduced the HKIS and the valuation profession in Hong Kong.

The HKIS Working Group and I visited the China Appraisal Society (CAS) on 23 October. The HKIS delegates met Mr Zhang Guochun, the CAS Secretary General and Madam Han Liying, the CAS Vice Secretary General, and Ms Qiu Suqin and Mr Zhang Wei from the Ministry of Finance. We discussed the arrangements for mutual recognition of qualifications and cooperation in business valuation and intellectual properties valuation.

HKIS representatives joined the Hong Kong delegation to attend the World Sustainable Building Conference 2014 (WSB14) held in Barcelona, Spain on 28 to 30 October. The Hong Kong delegation was one of the largest delegations to the WSB14, with a total of 110 members comprising of senior government officials, professional and public bodies, industry players and academia. The aim of the conference was to share views for developing a local action plan for tackling the challenges for (1) providing decent housing for the world's population, (2) reducing energy use and ecological footprint and (3) promoting an economic model which is sustainable and creates jobs.

Hong Kong has been awarded the right to host the next World Sustainable Built Environment Conference in 2017 in Hong Kong. The Institute will prepare for participating in this major event and showcase the contribution of surveyors in the development of a sustainable built environment.

The Lands Department issued the "Information Note relating to the Pilot Scheme for Arbitration on Land Premium" on 24 October that sets out the general information for applications for lease modification transactions which may be suitable for arbitration under the Pilot Scheme for Arbitration on Land Premium. The Pilot Scheme will be implemented for a trial period of two years from October subject to review by the Government. The HKIS General Practice Division has invited applications from its members and has prepared a list of qualified professional surveyors. This list of valuation professionals has been made available for reference on the Institute's website for the Government and the Applicant of Arbitration on Land Premium to appoint arbitrators to serve on the Arbitral Tribunal.

香港測量師學會 30 週年高爾夫球邀請賽,於 10 月 15 日在 東莞海逸高爾夫球會順利舉行。在秋風送爽,陽光温暖的天 氣下,香港測量師學會會員及嘉賓,包括工程師、律師和建 築師,進行了一天的友誼賽。香港測量師學會會長杯由產業 測量組勝出,而淨桿冠軍則由張保國測量師獲得。在此,我 感謝邀請賽的籌委會主席張達棠測量師及鄭偉雄測量師,他 們把是次高爾夫球賽辦得非常出色。

於 10 月 16 日,上海議會為會員舉辦了持續專業發展講 座,講題為「中國房地產商在海外發展」。我借是次活動的 機會,向出席的會員彙報了學會最新的發展,並瞭解他們在 上海的工作和生活的情况。

2014 年國際房地產估價論壇於 10 月 23 至 24 日在北京舉 行。論壇由中國房地產估價師與房地產經紀人學會及世界估 價組織協會主辦,新加坡測量師與估價師學會及香港測量師 學會協辦。我與學會代表出席了論壇,並介紹了學會和香港 的專業估值服務。

於 10 月 23 日,我與學會工作小組拜訪了中國資產評估協 會,學會代表與中國資產評估協會張國春秘書長、韓立英副 秘書長及財政部邱素琴處長和張巍副處長會面。在會上,我 們就資格互認、商業評估和知識產權評估方面交換了意見。

於 10 月 28 至 30 日,學會代表參與香港代表團出席於西 班牙巴塞隆拿舉行之「2014年度可持續建築發展全球會 議」。香港代表團是陣容最大的代表團之一,總共 110 名 成員參與,其中包括政府高級官員,專業和公共機構,業內 人士和學界代表團。會議主要目的是與世界各地專家交流切 磋,以應對持續建築發展面對的挑戰,並探索行動方案: (一)為全球人口提供優質的住房,(二)減少材料和能源消 耗及環境污染,(三)促進可持續發展和創造就業機會。

下屆「可持續建築發展全球會議」將由香港主辦並於 2017 年在香港舉行。學會將積極準備參與這次大型會議,以展示 香港測量師在可持續建築發展領域上的貢獻。

於 10 月 24 日,地政總署公佈了「補地價仲裁先導計劃參 考便覽」,供適合根據補地價仲裁先導計劃進行仲裁的土 地契約修訂交易的申請人參考。先導計劃於 10 月起試行兩 年,之後政府會作出檢討。學會產業測量組已向會員發出邀 請,申請加入先導計劃的仲裁員(估價專業)名單。學會網站 已提供了一份符合先導計劃要求的專業產業測量師名單,以 供政府和仲裁申請人參考。

Shanghai Forum Dinner cum CPD seminar

On 16th October 2014, the President Sr Simon Kwok, Immediate Past President and Chairman of Mainland Affairs Committee Sr Stephen Lai, Vice-Chairman of Mainland Affairs Committee Sr Cheung Hau Wai, Hon. Secretary Sr Thomas Ho and Hon. Treasurer Sr Dick Kwok visited Shanghai and held a dinner gathering with HKIS members. About 35 members joined the gathering. The President addressed the participants with a review of the latest developments of the Institute, and the Chairman of Mainland Affairs Committee gave an overview of the events organized by the Shanghai Forum and the Beijing Forum during this year.

The highlight of the dinner was a CPD seminar presented by Sr Stanley Chow on the topic "Chinese Developers Marching Overseas". Sr Chow delivered an in-depth review of the challenges faced by Chinese developers when investing in property markets in countries such as Australia, the U.S. and South Korea. The seminar was very informative and Sr Chow shared his personal experiences in engaging QS consultants with global presence.

INTERNATIONAL REAL ESTATE VALUATION CONFERENCE 2014 and WAVO BOARD MEETING

Report By Sr Edward AU HKIS Vice President

An international conference was jointly hosted by the China Institute of Real Estate Appraisers and Agents (CIREA) and the World Association of Valuation Organisations (WAVO) and co-organized by the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors (HKIS) and the Singapore Institute of Surveyors and Valuers (SISV), between 23 and 24 October 2014 in Beijing. The theme of this international conference was **"Global Developments in Real Estate Valuation – Methods, Standards and Best Practices"**. HKIS played an important role in organizing this event jointly with the other two key organizer - SISV and CIREA.

In recent years much development has taken place around the world, particularly for real estate in Asia. The global financial crisis has left a severe impact on the financial sector. Valuation of real estate and other assets have been examined in greater detail to ensure that the financial worth of these assets was the same as what they have been valued at and that were capable of achieving their values. There was a need to develop and establish guidelines and standards as well as best practices for real estate valuation, and for the purpose of valuing for accounting and financial reporting purposes. This international conference was intended to provide a valuable platform for real estate valuers to discuss some of the prevailing issues relating to standards and practices, and explore other new developments in the field of valuation.

This year, WAVO held its conference jointly with CIREA in Beijing. The event attracted over 300 attendees from different part of the Mainland and other countries. Speakers from Singapore, Hong Kong, India, the United States, Germany and China presented topics on various hot topics including new trends in real estate valuation methods, leasehold valuation, discounted cash flow techniques; specialized valuations for hotel and resort valuation, subterranean rights valuation; statutory valuations for property tax assessment, land acquisition, development charge; valuation standards and best practices including international and local standards and practices; ethics and professionalism and the real estate market and development in terms of investments, market cycles, controls and regulations. The presentations in the conference received a high degree of recognition and appreciation by attendees.

By chance, WAVO held its 2014 Board Meeting in Beijing on the day before the conference. Sr Edward AU represented the HKIS, being a member association of the WAVO, in joining the WAVO Board Meeting. The WAVO Board discussed and planned its business plan for the year 2015. Since the last WAVO Board Meeting, which was held on 9 May 2014 in the HKIS Office, it was noted that there was a changing and challenging environment for the valuation profession and as such there was a need for a revamp of the Organization. A new work plan for the coming year and also the strategy to be adopted to expand its membership were discussed during the Board Meeting. Members noted the need for a stronger presence of the valuation profession and that WAVO had to reinvent itself and expand its network amongst the valuation organizations. The Meeting enhanced the progress and cooperation between members and targeted to expand WAVO membership towards other regions around the world.

HKIS Vice President Sr Edward AU presented a talk on the surveying profession in the forum. His presentation covered issues relating to the latest developments and role of surveying professionals in the construction and real estate industries and the close interactions with other professions including architects and planners, thereby providing new insights to the audience in the forum.



Having served the Institute for over ten years, from the Divisional Council to the General Council, my accumulated experiences and observations gave me a good idea of the priority and necessity of what to focus on during my Presidency. Meanwhile, I must again thank my predecessors and fellow Council members who tendered great support for and advice to me along the way.

As the HKIS's membership approaches 8,000, it has reviewed the strength of its administration and corporate governance to cope with competition from other professional institutions and the heightened expectations from the public and members. We believe a fundamental success factor is to uphold the quality of our recruits and to focus on our members' professional development.

You may recall that 2012 was an "Election Year". With the other professional institutes, the HKIS co-organised two special forums. One was for the Chief Executive election and the other was for the Legislative Council election, as we are under the Architectural Surveying and Planning Functional Constituency. Incidentally, both elections had candidates who were past HKIS Presidents. Therefore, they drew great attention from the surveying profession. We also became the talk of the town because during the year, topics such as "unauthorised building works" had raised the public's awareness of us significantly. Meanwhile, such exposure also posed great challenges to us once the public gueries on the competency of surveying professionals and the specialisations among our different divisions started to come in. Thanks to our spokespersons and members who managed to provide impartial and professional answers to the queries, which enhanced the public's perception of us.

That year also witnessed a relatively unhealthy property market, leading the government to impose measures to attempt to manager it. As one of Hong Kong's major property-related professional institutions, we were frequently approached by the media and the government on issues related to it. Last, but not least, the preparations to relocate our office happened during my term. As with other commercial tenants, the HKIS also faced escalating rents and had to identify more affordable premises to control our costs.



Arbitrators (Valuation Expert) under the Pilot Scheme for Arbitration on Land Premium

The HKIS General Practice Division (GPD) invited Professional Surveyors in the GPD to apply for listing in the List of Valuation Expert as Arbitrator under the Pilot Scheme for Arbitration on Land Premium (the List) by e-mail on 30 August 2014. The vetting panel completed the vetting procedure for the first batch applicants and 61 Professional Surveyors in the GPD are in the List as at 31 October 2014. The List is available on HKIS GPD webpage. The Pro Forma CV of the listed Professional Surveyors will soon be uploaded on the webpage for public reference. Professional Surveyors in the GPD wishing to apply may contact the HKIS Administrative Office for details.

Visit of Shenzhen Society of Certified Public Appraisers

A delegation of three representatives from the Shenzhen Society of Certified Public Appraisers led by Mr Li Xiheng visited the HKIS in the morning of 29 September 2014. The delegates were welcomed by the Chairman of the GPD, Sr Joseph Ho. Views on intellectual properties valuation and development in Hong Kong were exchanged.



Talk on Valuation to the Planning Department, Hong Kong SAR

The GPD Chairman Sr Joseph Ho was invited by the Planning Department of the HKSAR to give a talk on "Dialogue with

Professionals in Planning Related Fields" in the afternoon of 29 September 2014. In the talk, Sr Joseph Ho briefly described real property valuation flow chart and valuation procedures; in doing so, addressing factors to be considered in real property valuation which include internal and external factors; and, how town planning can affect the value of real properties. In the discussion session, Sr Joseph Ho and the participants exchanged views on the impacts of planning action in revitalising Kowloon East, and how the market reacted to such regeneration initiatives.

Visit the China Appraisal Society

The President Sr Simon Kwok together with the Working Group members: Vice President Sr Edward Au, the GPD Chairman Sr Joseph Ho and GPD Council Co-opted Member Sr Elsa Ng paid a visit to the China Appraisal Society (CAS) in the afternoon of 23 October 2014. The HKIS delegates were welcomed by Mr Zhang Guochun, the Secretary General (張 國春秘書長) and Madam Han Living, Vice Secretary General (韓立英副秘書長), of CAS, Ms Qiu Sugin (邱素琴處長) and Mr Zhang Wei (張巍副處長) from the Ministry of Finance. In the meeting, Sr Joseph Ho led the discussion on reciprocity arrangement and suggested different scenarios that both HKIS and CAS could work together to promote business valuation and intellectual properties valuation in the Greater China. Both parties also exchanged views on the possibility to introduce a reciprocity arrangement among the parties. 

企業融資和資產估值的關係 系列二

CPD on Asset Management for General Practice Surveyors

The CPD event on "Asset Management for General Practice Surveyors" conducted by Sr Joseph Ho, Chairman of the General Practice Division, was successfully held on 8 October with about 50 members taking part in the seminar. First of all, Joseph defined the generic term of asset management and its relationship with the corporate finance, property management and facilities management. By using some userfriendly graphics, Joseph showed us the lifecycle for asset and general asset management process from its initial planning stage; followed by acquisition, deployment, maintenance and finally to its retirement stage to illustrate the involvement of different surveying professions in the management of assets including but not limited to financial asset, infrastructure asset or enterprise asset. Lastly, Joseph reminded us that GPD Council members met representatives from Non-bank Financial Institutions Supervision Division of the PRC China Banking Regulatory Commission in Shanghai in June 2014 to discuss further collaboration between the HKIS and the Division to promote asset management in China in future.
