PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Presidential Address

I am most honoured to assume the presidency from our Immediate Past President, Sr Simon Kwok. I take this opportunity to tender my heartfelt gratitude to Simon and the outgoing council for their great work over the past year.

The present development of the HKIS is a result of the unfailing and continuous efforts of our members, particularly our senior members, over the past three decades. We shall ride on our current achievements and continue to keep up our international and regional presence, extend our connections with our Mainland counterparts, and uphold our professional standards to maintain and strengthen the status of surveyors in Hong Kong.



However, I have learnt that many members still believe there is a lack of awareness of the HKIS in the public eye. Although we have a lot of successful members practicing in the industry and anchoring many key positions in prominent organisations, many people still cannot differentiate between our six divisions. To a certain extent, not many non-surveyors can identify the roles and services of a professional surveyor. This may be attributed to our relatively "low-profile" or "humble professional" approach in reaching out to the public. Without making others more aware of our expertise and contributions to society, it may be increasingly difficult for the HKIS to attract new blood. It may also be a stumbling block for the healthy development of our profession.

So, in the coming year, I will place particular focus on and efforts to promote our corporate image, as well as the functions and roles of surveyors in society in a collective manner. We will engage a PR firm to assist us to carry out a series of major promotional exercises. I hereby appeal for your support to implement the task for the long term benefit of the Institute and the better prospects for our members.

As a professional body playing a vital social role, the HKIS should assume a proactive role in voicing its professional views and opinions on public and social policies that directly or indirectly relate to the core competencies and knowledge of professional surveyors in Hong Kong.

In recent years, the views and proposals of the HKIS have successfully attracted the attention of the government and the public. However, many members believe there is room for us to do more. I will set up more platforms to solicit greater contributions from our more experienced members on various issues relating to our profession and consolidate the wider views and suggestions of members, particularly younger members, on public and social issues relevant to us. Given the professional knowledge and wisdom of our surveyors, the HKIS should be able to contribute more to the better development of Hong Kong.

In parallel, enhanced professional education and training have become more critical than before for raising the competence of our probationers and the competitiveness of newly-qualified members. With the great efforts of the six divisions, we have held over 170 CPD events or talks over the past year to support members' continuous professional

development. However, there may be a pressing need to introduce certain "focused" or "intensive" professional trainings for new professional members, so as to nurture more "experts" on various core areas of surveyors' services and to support and sustain the further development of the HKIS.

I hope you will share in my concerns and be equipped for the "challenges and changes" that will occur in a not-tooremote future.

Last, but not least, I wish to thank you in advance for the effort of the incoming council and your support to the Institute in the year to come.

因此,在未來的一年,我將專注提升學會的企業形象,以及 測量師在社會上的功能和角色。我們將聘請公關公司,協助 學會推行一系列廣泛的宣傳活動。我在此呼籲各會員以學會 長遠利益為前題,支持及協助我們推行這項宣傳計劃,為會 員建立更理想的前景。

作為一個有重要社會角色的專業團體,學會將繼往開來,利 用測量專業及知識,以積極的態度,就與我們專業相關的公 共及社會政策,提供意見。

Sr Tse Wai Chuen Tony was the President of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors from 2003 to 2004. Sr Tse has more than 35 years experience working in the real estate industry. Apart from his professional work, Sr Tse has been a keen participant in community affairs. At various times, he has been a member of the Town Planning Board, the Land and Building Advisory Committee, the Municipal Services Appeal Panel, the Disciplinary Board Panel (Land Survey), the Hong Kong Trade Development Council Infrastructure Development Advisory Committee, and the Chairman of the Real Estate Services Training Board of Vocational Training Council. Sr Tse is now the HKSAR Legislative Council Member for the Architectural, Surveying and Planning Functional Constituency,

Major Developments as HKIS President

As part of the Closer Economic Partnership Arrangement (CEPA) between the Mainland and Hong Kong, the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors and the China Institute of Real Estate Appraisers signed a reciprocity agreement on 4 November 2003 for General Practice Surveyors in Hong Kong and real estate appraisers in the Mainland. The first training and test session under the agreement was held in March 2004 with the qualification certificates being presented to the successful candidates on 20 August 2004. Sr Tse still remembered the tremendous time and effort spent in the preparation of training material, inviting training staff, logistical arrangements and the fine detail of the accreditation method. Sr Tse believed this agreement was remarkable as it enhanced the opportunities of practitioners and the influence of Hong Kong industry practices in the Mainland and so constituted one of his major achievements during his term of service as HKIS President.

There was another interesting development during his term of service, the redesign of the HKIS's publication - *Surveyors Times*. The *Surveyors Times* used to be a leaflet with polycolour printing. It was changed to a magazine with more attractive elements after input from Sr Tse and other members. Sr Tse believes the *Surveyors Times* is vital as a tool of communication between Institute and its members and also gives opportunities to increase public awareness and understanding of the Institute. It therefore deserved a more attractive appearance, rich content and additional resources.

Development of the Institute in the Past 10 Years

Sr Tse mentioned he was pleased that there was increasing public awareness towards surveyors in Hong Kong. The Institute is now providing advice and guidelines on different types of surveying related services such as forms of construction contract, building maintenance, and in the sale and purchase of properties such that they allow the public to better understand the role and duties of surveyors. To serve the community better, Sr Tse suggests that the Institute should produce simpler guidelines which people at large can understand in additional to those for use by professionals. This can further enhance the image and reputation of surveyors. Sr Tse also mentioned that the success of the Institute rests with the effort and the unity of the six divisions of HKIS. The divisions should continue to work together for an even better development of the professionalism and reputation of the Institute in the future.

A Word for Young Surveyors

Sr Tse said that there were undoubtedly fewer opportunities for Young Surveyors nowadays in Hong Kong compared with the years before. However Young Surveyors should not be discouraged at the reduced opportunities for advancement. Instead it is the young people's edge in the quick adoption of new knowledge and technology that would eventually give them the advantage. They are especially suitable for new developments in the surveying sector such as Building Information Modelling (BIM). Young Surveyors should understand their strengths and further enhance their strengths in addition to their daily work. Another suggestion from Sr Tse was that there were new lines of work in the industry gradually emerging in recent years such as provision of different types of multi-professional services. Young Surveyors should not be limited by the traditional role of surveyors and should take the opportunity to try new types of career development.

Seminars on Financial Reporting

Due to the implementation of the fair value hierarchy in financial statement reports, there exist some disclosure issues between GP surveyors and auditors regarding financial report valuations. To help both professions move forward, I was invited by Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu Hong Kong to attend and discuss "The Relationship between Valuers and Auditors in preparing/Assessing Valuations for Financial Statement Purposes" during the 2014 Deloitte China National Real Estate Industry Practice Annual Seminar on 27 November 2014. Over 80 people attended. I was also invited by BDO Limited Hong Kong to participate in a workshop known as "Investment Property Valuation" in the SLC on 9 December 2014. Over 150 BDO Limited staff attended the workshop.

Promotion of IP Valuation

For the past two years, I have worked hard to promote our GP capabilities in IP (intellectual property) valuation. With the kind assistance of the Hon Sr Tony Tse, Sr Edward Au, and members of the HKIS Executive Committee (ExeCom), I successfully obtained, after negotiations, an agreement from the Trade Development Council to provide a free exhibition booth to HKIS members who provide IP valuations in Hong Kong to promote their businesses at the BIP Asia Forum from 4-5 December 2014.

To facilitate this first-ever promotional opportunity to GPD members and their firms, I invited those firms that provided IP valuations to the public and responded to my e-mail of 29 May 2014 and the subsequent follow-up calls from the HKIS

Secretariat to attend a briefing session on 2 December 2014 at HKIS headquarters. Representatives from seven firms attended the session, during which I briefed them on the background and development of this first-ever opportunity. Reminder of the Application to be listed on the HKIS's List of Firms Providing Professional Consultancy Services in General Practice Surveying

From time to time, the GPD Council receives applications from GP members to list their firms on the HKIS's List of Firms Providing Professional Consultancy Services in General Practice Surveying. Firms that wish to be listed have to confirm that they fulfill the following requirements:

- 1. Be a firm registered in Hong Kong.
- 2. Be a firm that provides the external professional consultancy services of a general practice surveyor.
- 3. Have at least one corporate member of the HKIS's GPD working full time in a senior position.

The GPD Council considers that a description of "Corp" in the Nature of Business column of a valid Business Registration does not satisfy the requirement of "a firm that provides the external professional consultancy services of a general practice surveyor" unless such services are expressly stated in the provided firm's Articles of Association and Memorandum.

Reciprocity arrangement

During the recent GPD Council meeting, members agreed in principle to proceed further discussion with the China Appraisal Society about possible reciprocity arrangement. A discussion forum will be organised simultaneously in the coming months to collect members' views on such arrangement.



The Coming Collapse of China's Property Market, or Will it?

Reported by Kent Yeung

The CPD event titled, "The Coming Collapse of China's Property Market, or Will it?" was successfully held on 27 November 2014. Our guest speaker, Mr Chi Lo, senior economist at BNP Paribas Investment Partners (Asia), Ltd., presented a macroeconomic analysis of the fundamental factors in China's major cities by estimating the degree of housing bubbles. He then elaborated on the economic impact of property investment growth on GDP growth in China's cities. For the Hong Kong market, Mr Lo explained the impact of raising interest rates on the property market and analysed the relationship between the linked exchange rate system and money flows, which substantially affects property investment intentions.

With around 100 participants, the talk gave everyone good insights into the property markets in Hong Kong and China from a macroeconomic perspective. Similar to previous seminars by Mr Lo, our members eagerly stayed behind and actively participated in the Q&A session on future property market trends in China and Hong Kong.
