會長的話 RESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The 2015-2016 Budget

Amid the discussions after Financial Secretary John Tsang's delivery of The 2015 - 2016 Budget Speech, our attention is naturally drawn to the availability of sufficient financial resources to support the necessary land development and housing construction to meet Hong Kong's pressing needs. The Institute issued a prompt response to the announced budget immediately on 25 February after the speech.

Representatives of the HKIS and I attended a luncheon on 27 March organised by The Hong Kong Coalition of Professional Services with Mr Tsang as the guest speaker. The topic of the luncheon was "How to Generate Sufficient Revenue to Meet Hong Kong's Long-term Needs". The FS has answered the question by reference to honing the physical capabilities of his fencing team. He said that without an outstanding physique, a fencer cannot perform well. He also suggested that if Hong Kong was to maintain a good physique, it should be able to create and generate sufficient to meet its needs. I dwelled on this point and asked Mr FS if he was prepared to allocate specific and dedicated financial resources to building professional institutes like the HKIS to allow them to enhance the training of young professionals and to strengthen their "physique" to meet the ever-escalating demands and expectations of society.

Engagement of Hong Kong Consultant for a Foreign Aid Construction Project (香港顧問諮詢企業試點承擔援外監理任務)

After almost two years of liaising and negotiating with the Ministry of Commerce, one of the HKIS's member building surveying firms, Fruit Design and Build Ltd, successfully won one of the pilot project supervision services consultancy contracts for two foreign aid construction projects put out by the MOC. I am very proud of an HKIS member firm's success in getting the appointment and having the opportunity to help the Chinese Government reach out. I want to see HKIS members to have more opportunities to participate in similar projects in the future.

Talk during the Building Safety Week 2015

It was my great honour to be invited to deliver a seminar talk during the closing ceremony of the Building Safety Week 2015 organised by the Buildings Department from 14-20 March.



A lack of proper building maintenance may only be one of the reasons for the current building safety problems that Hong Kong faces. I attempted to re-think the root causes of "building safety" problems in my talk from a holistic perspective. Inherent defects in a building's original design, the use of improper or non-durable materials, unsatisfactory workmanship, misuse by building owners or users, and mismanagement may probably have also led to various building problems in Hong Kong. To minimise or, ideally, prevent similar safety problems for newer buildings, it is high time for us to critically re-think and review how we can design and construct our buildings in a better way.

Building Maintenance Cost Data

On 12 March 2015, The University of Hong Kong (HKU) organised a press briefing and announced its study on building maintenance cost and the launch of an online platform, the Building Maintenance Cost Data and Estimator, commissioned by the ICAC. HKU conducted this empirical research based on building maintenance cost data from Operation Building Bright (樓宇更新大行動). I am glad to see that there are now more cost data for building owners' reference.

The Building Surveying Division is now updating the cost data it prepared a few years ago and it is expected that an updated set of data to be available within 2-3months' time.

From time to time building surveyors are asked to advise on the maintenance costs of buildings by the media, relatives, colleagues, and friends. It is important to educate owners that when they refer to a particular set of data, they must understand how it was derived. For example, the data from the Building Maintenance Cost Data and Estimator refer to the minimal cost to restore a building to a "healthy" standard, but do not include improvement works such as upgrading lift lobby, installing air conditioners at common areas or adding building covers to open car parks.

With more cost data available in the market, it is hoped that unreasonably high renovation costs (天價維修費) will become history. But will this solve the problem of "tenderrigging" (圍標) permanently? Will some owners still pay for unnecessary repair works? How about the quality of the repairs? In my opinion, the government should take the lead in devising a control mechanism to holistically tackle these problems.

Training is very important to our probationers and newly-qualified members and we will continue to explore different areas of training with the CPD Panel.

Building Safety Week 2015

"Building Safety Week 2015" was organised by the Buildings Department, with the HKIS as a supporting organisation. The event was successfully held from 14-20 March 2015 in the Jockey Club Innovation Tower at the Hong Kong Polytechnic University.

Building safety is an area of our core skill and we should work with the Buildings Department and stakeholders to change the mindsets of building owners and make them realizing the need to take care of their buildings proactively. The recent collapse of concrete fins above an air-conditioner hood, which caused a domestic helper to lose her foot, could have been avoided if the building owner had proactively engaged a professional building inspector to inspect the building. There have been too many unnecessary accidents caused by dilapidated buildings in recent years and I believe that they could have been avoided by proactive maintenance. Mandatory Building and Window Inspection Schemes only randomly detect aged buildings and their coverage hardly blankets the large volume of old buildings in Hong Kong within a short period.




Monthly Happy Hour Gathering





Extension of the "AP Easy" Building Maintenance Advisory Service Scheme

With the success of the implementation of the "AP Easy" Building Maintenance Advisory Service Scheme (hereafter the Scheme), which went into effect on 1 April 2014, and upon the request of the Home Affairs Department (HAD), the Scheme will be extended for another year from April 2015 to March 2016, so as to allow more time for the OCs to appoint APs with the assistance of expert teams and render help to more OCs. The HKIS's Building Surveying Division and Property and Facility Management Division, together with the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers and the Hong Kong Institute of Architects, will continue to provide pro bono professional and tailor-made advisory and support service

to Owners Corporations (OCs) to help them appoint APs to carry out building maintenance works.

The Scheme is intended to guide the OCs on how to appoint a competent and appropriate project consultant and provide basic knowledge for OCs to monitor the performance of consultants. Members are not supposed to get involved in the actual assessment of the building conditions and details of the repair works – not even in the specific cost aspect, which should be more properly dealt with by the respective consultant appointed. Members should also not become involved in the works supervision stage of the building repair works.

Cooperative Agreement between CECA and the HKIS

A cooperative agreement to translate the Chinese version of the "National Standard of the People's Republic of China – Code of bills of quantities and valuation for construction works" (建設工程工程量清單計價規範) (GB50500-2013) into English was signed between the China Engineering Cost Association (CECA) and Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors (HKIS) in early August 2014. The engaged translation services provider was Messrs KC Tang Consultants, Ltd. The purpose of the translation was to let CECA's counterparts gain a more thorough understanding of the current standards promulgated by the MoHURD on the preparation of bills of quantities and the valuation of construction works. This would hopefully enhance the standing of the National Standard internationally.

The English version of the Code was reviewed by a panel of CECA-appointed experts consisting of Xie Hong-xue (謝洪學), Shu Yu (舒宇), Anita Liu Mei-mai (廖美薇), Tommy Yim (嚴汝江), and Jacob Lam (林清錦).

After several months of translating the Code, the panel of experts; the service provider's representative, Sr Tang Kicheung; and the QSD's representatives, Sr Keith Yim and I, attended a half-day meeting in Shenzhen to discuss how to wrap up the work on 4 March 2015. Shortly after this meeting, it was announced that the translation would be completed and reviewed by Spring 2015.

New Members Welcoming Party

The QSD New Members Welcoming Party was originally arranged to be held at a Western restaurant in Central on 4 March 2015. Due to overwhelming interest, the party was moved to a bigger venue at the Staff Club, 5/F, Communal Building, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University.

This year, over 100 participants (including new members, their friends and families, QSD Council Members, Past QSD Chairmen, and HKIS EC Members) joined the party. The QSD Council Members and past QSD Chairmen gladly met

with the freshest faces during this jovial and casual event. It was our great honour that the Senior Vice President of the Institute, Sr Edward Au, was able to attend the event and give an impressive speech to the newly-qualified members. I had the great pleasure to represent the QSD Council to introduce to our newest members the functions of its various sub-committees and organising committees in the hope that they would inspire more of our younger surveyors to participate in the Council's important activities. In order to sustain the QSD Council's development, we need to inject new blood into it on a regular basis. The party provided us with a platform to promote the Council's work and, hence, encourage members to contribute their efforts to the QSD Council. At this party, we were also grateful to have in attendance our Vice President, Sr Thomas Ho; other Divisional Chairmen; and the YSG Chairman.

The creative games played during the party gave it a cheerful atmosphere. Everybody joined in and enjoyed the experience. Before the party ended, I had the honour to conduct the lucky draw.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the Chairperson, Sr Christina Wong, and the OC members of the New Members Welcoming Party Organising Committee for their great efforts in organising such a successful event.















Communication Meeting between the ACQS, DevB, ArchSD, and HKIS

The Communication Meeting between the Association of Consultant Quantity Surveyors (ACQS), the Development Bureau (DevB), the Architectural Services Department (ArchSD), and the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors (HKIS) was held at the Queensway Government offices on 23 March 2015.

The meeting was chaired by the Director of ArchSD, Sr KK Leung, and attended by his senior officials; representatives from the ACQS and DevB; and representatives from the HKIS's QSD, Sr Keith Yim, Sr Honby Chan, Sr Raymond Kam, and I.

During the meeting, a number of items were discussed. The HKIS raised the following issues:

1. Use of a Standard Form of Contract for Maintenance and Renovation Works published by the HKIS

It was suggested to use this form for any major repair to be carried out in school projects. The ArchSD aired its observations on the new terms for the different parties in this form and its acceptance by the construction industry. The HKIS agreed to observe and seek collaborative efforts with the HKIA and HKICM.

2. Use of BIM in ArchSD projects

The ArchSD selected some projects for testing BIM and will continuously review its use in its projects. As the Housing Department widely employs BIM technology, it was proposed that the ArchSD may consult with the Housing Department to see if a common standard may be adopted for BIM.

3. Use of NEC in ArchSD projects

The HKIS raised concerns over the applicability and suitability of using NEC in building works projects. The ArchSD advised that it had adopted NEC in three projects on a trial basis, with another three scheduled to adopt it in 2016. The ArchSD also selected a QS consultancy agreement to test the use of an NEC Professional Services Contract (PSC) in three future projects.

The HKIS Quantity Surveying Division Scholarship Programme (2014-2015)

After receiving nominations from the University of Hong Kong ("HKU"), the Hong Kong Polytechnic University



("PolyU"), the City University of Hong Kong ("CityU"), and the Hong Kong Institute of Vocational Education ("IVE"), a vetting committing comprising QSD office Bearers and Council Members was set up and recommended 18 awardees after screening.

On behalf of the QSD Council, I have sent invitations to the awardees; department heads of HKU, PolyU, CityU, and IVE; and corporate sponsors to join the scholarship presentation ceremony at the Surveyors Learning Centre on 1 April 2015. I have also invited HKIS GC Members, QSD Office Bearers, and QSD Council Members to join. I look forward to meeting everyone at the ceremony.

Third Batch of Assessments to **Qualify CECA and HKIS Members**

Back in February 2013, the QSD Council sent a questionnaire to QSD members at large to enquire about their interest in joining the third batch of assessment exercises if CECA and the HKIS agreed to conduct them. As the response was quite positive, the QSD Council discussed this matter with CECA several times. Following the discussion with CECA on 13 March 2015, both parties agreed to more specific terms for concluding the supplementary agreement. We expect that its execution by both parties will be conducted during the third quarter of this year. Once the supplementary agreement is executed, the HKIS will inform members accordingly.

QSD APC Assessments

This year's APC Part I written assessment will be held in mid-August 2015, while the APC Part II written assessment will be held on two days in mid-September 2015. The deadline for applying for either assessment is 30 June 2015.

After the introduction of the new APC System in July 2011, the QSD revised the Divisional Rules and Guides for the APC assessment. The new system took effect in May 2012. As a reminder, the old APC system, which coexisted with the new APC system until 2014, has ended.

The current APC system has re-grouped its core and elective competencies. The critical analysis adopted by the old APC system is no longer required. Candidates should refer to the new Rules and Guidelines, which may be downloaded from the HKIS website at http://www.hkis.org.hk/hkis/papers/qsd/APCQS-RuleNGuide.pdf for more details.

In order to help candidates familiarise themselves with the QSD APC Parts I and II, the QSD will conduct two Part I workshops on 18 April and 6 June 2015 and two Part II workshops on 25 April and 27 June 2015.

During the Part I workshop, candidates will be introduced to the requirements for and assessment criteria of Part I and given some sample questions. A review of the questions and expected answers of the Part I written assessments performed from 2012-2014 will also be conducted as a supplementary introduction. Probationers and student members who plan to take the Part I assessment are encouraged to attend one of the Part I workshops.

The Part II workshop should help candidates gain a better understanding of the requirements and techniques required to solve the written practical problems of the Part II assessment using critical and analytical thinking. It will focus on discussing the ways to identify the key issues in different types of questions, the expected answers from previous papers, interviews, diaries or logbooks, and PQSL. Associate members, probationers, and student members who plan to take the Part II assessment are encouraged to attend one of the Part II workshops.

At each APC workshop, a forum will be provided for candidates to know more about the assessors' expectations. Discussions will be held in small groups, each headed by an experienced assessor. Interaction is expected between assessors and candidates. Topics will include both pre- and post-contract issues.

Updates on CPD Events in 2015 & the First CPD in Macau

In my last Chairman's Message, I mentioned that the CPD Sub-Committee has organised about 50 high quality CPD events every year since 2012 on a variety of topics.

For members' information, the QSD has arranged 35 CPD events for 2015 up to August (of which 19 are scheduled for April to August), with another 15 events (talks, workshops, and site visits) to be announced in the year to come.

I am also happy to announce that the first CPD in Macau (on contractor bonds there) will be held on 14 May 2015. Members working in Macau are cordially invited to join this event, which is most relevant to their on-hand jobs.

心境年輕測量師月尾感性系列 (二) -以前做過乜 宜家做緊乜

The happy hour gathering titled, "以前做過乜 宜家做緊乜," was organised by the LSD and successfully held on 13 March 2015 at Backstage Live Restaurant in Central. We had the honour to invite Sr Amy Lau and Sr Lesly Lam to share their work experiences as surveying professionals in the government and private sectors with members. The topic of discussion attracted over 30 members from the different divisions.

Sr Amy and Sr Lesly both quit their civil service positions as estate surveyor and land surveyor before going to work for the private sector. They evaluated the difference between the scopes of the works, their management approaches, and the skill sets applied to these two distinct environments. Although the government and private sector have different roles in land development, their impact on this activity is the same. One major reason behind our speakers' decisions to exit the government in favour of private developers was that they wanted to apply their experiences, professional

knowledge, and enthusiasm to the industry by facilitating different development projects.

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Visit to a Concrete Batching Plant

Reported by Sr Joe Wu and Sr William Poon, Members of the QSD CPD Sub-Committee, & Sr C.W. Tang and Sr Gary Chan, Members of the BSD CPD Sub-Committee.

The BSD and QSD CPD Sub-Committees jointly organised a visit to a concrete batching plant operated by Golik Concrete (HK), Ltd (hereafter "Golik") on 14 March 2015. The batching plant is located on Tong Yan San Tsuen Road, Yuen Long. The visit covered two main areas: 1) a laboratory trial demonstration and 2) a batching plant tour.

The welcome speech and introduction were given by the Operations Manager, Mr Nick Rothwell, and the Technical Manager, Mr H.K. Wong.

During the laboratory trial demonstration, Golik's technical staff demonstrated the process that leads to 'self-compacting concrete' by adding Hyperplasticisers (polycarboxylates) to concrete. This liquid additive reduces the amount of water needed to produce concrete, which improves its flow characteristics and workability while keeping the same production process and strengthening the concrete by decreasing its water-to-cement ratio.



Laboratory Trial Demonstration

After the laboratory trial demonstration, members were guided on a visit to a fully automated concrete batching plant that incorporates advanced control systems technology to measure the ingredients of concrete to their required

quantities and tolerances. Materials, once weighed, are discharged from the weigh hoppers into the central mixing unit, where water and admixture are added. From here it takes just a matter of seconds to fully mix a 3.0m3 batch of concrete. The whole process is controlled by a state-of-the-art, purposed-made computer and software, which minimises human error.

Throughout this visit, members gained valuable knowledge of the manufacture of concrete by learning about the systematic and well-controlled concrete mixing process and the application of admixture to it. Everyone enjoyed this visit and actively participated in the laboratory trial demonstration and plant visiting sessions. We want to thank Mr Nick Rothwell and Mr H.K. Wong for sharing their knowledge of concrete with us.

After the visit, a lunch was arranged at a restaurant in Yuen Long. It was a good opportunity for members to share their reactions to the visit and socialise while enjoying the food.

Visit to Nurseries

The QSD CPD Sub-Committee organised visits to two nurseries followed by a barbecue lunch on 21 March 2015. The schedule was tight, but not a rush.

The first stop was Tai Po Tung Tze Nursery (大埔洞梓苗圃, hereafter "Tung Tze"), which was the largest nursery of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (hereafter "LCSD"). Tung Tze was divided into different areas: Trees Area, Shrubs Area, Creepers Area, Annuals Area, etc. The LCSD staff at Tung Tze started by introducing the different steps of propagation, including the collection of seeds and branches, irrigation, fertilisation, and transplants.

The LCSD staff and four arborists, Mr Stanley Tsui, Ms Homie Ho, Mr Kenny Lau, and Ms Lam Pak Sin, from Tak Tai Enviroscape, Ltd (hereafter "Tak Tai") also introduced an unusual plant to us, Passiflora alata (大果西番蓮), which is a winged-stem passion flower with red curved petals and a prominent fringed corona in bands of purple and white. It became the star of the day and many members took photographs with this interesting flower. Additional focus fell on Perilla frutescens (紫蘇), which, unlike the common green colour of perilla, could be propagated in various colours.

After visiting Tung Tze, members proceeded to Tak Tai's nearby nursery. If Tung Tze was a garden, Tak Tai resembled a jungle. The two nurseries gave members different feelings. They felt like they were in a treasure hunt in Tak Tai because when they walked around its nursery, they had no idea what special plant species awaited them at every checkpoint.

In addition, Tak Tai's arborists told members about the issues they needed to consider for pricing soft landscaping works and showed them an old proven way to detect underground water points by using two steel bars. When the bars touched, that meant there was a water point underneath.

What was a good activity for concluding the visits? Nothing other than a barbecue. Members gathered around a fire and shared their experiences and what they discovered during the visits.

Visit to Sewage Treatment Works

The BSD and QSD CPD Sub-Committees jointly organised a visit to Stanley Sewage Treatment Works (hereafter "STW") operated by the Drainage Services Department (hereafter "DSD") on 24 March 2015.

Before starting the tour, a welcome speech and introduction were given by an engineer from the DSD. With the aid of a video, Powerpoint presentation, and model, members could easily understand the basic concept and construction technology of the STW.

The sewage treatment process was divided into five steps. The first and second steps were screening and de-gritting, respectively. During these processes, the collected sewage was screened by a mechanical bar and directed to a detritor and grit classifier for grit removal. The sewage was then

delivered to an aeration tank, in which the microorganisms (activated sludge) biologically assimilated pollutants into the sewage. Fourth, the treated sewage and activated sludge were separated in the final sedimentation tanks. After final sedimentation, the effluents were disinfected by a sodium hypochlorite solution before being discharged.

What makes this STW special was its geographical location. It was the first STW built inside a cavern in Hong Kong. Stanley STW mainly comprised three caverns that were connected by a series of access and ventilation tunnels and shafts. It was amazing that there was a giant STW surrounded by a beautiful sea view and beach. Due to the cavern's airtight design, its air quality had to be maintained in good condition. Ceiling-mounted air sampling tubes were used to detect the toxic gas content (e.g. carbon monoxide, methane, etc.) in its air. Once the toxic gas content exceeds a certain level, an alarm will be triggered.

Our members enjoyed the briefing and tour of the STW. They believed that it was worth sacrificing half a work day to attend.
