



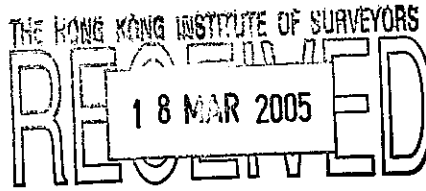


If your organization is interested in attending the meeting, please complete and return the attached reply slip by **21 March 2005**. Please limit the number of your representatives to two. If your organization wishes to address the Subcommittee in Putonghua, please notify us in advance so that necessary arrangements can be made.

In line with our usual practice, the meeting will be held in public and written submission received will be made available to the media and the public, and uploaded onto the website of the Legislative Council, unless you have advised otherwise. You may also wish to note that when addressing the Subcommittee, your representatives are not covered by the protection and immunity provided under the Legislative Council (Powers and Privileges) Ordinance (Cap. 382). Your written submission is also not covered by the Ordinance.

On the date of the meeting, representatives are requested to arrive **10 minutes before the scheduled meeting time**. On arrival at the Legislative Council Building, they are required to obtain entry passes at the Security Control Post at the entrance beside the carpark before proceeding to the Ante-Chamber on the first floor. They will be invited to join the meeting when members are ready. Please note that representatives are required to wear the entry passes at all times while in the Building and return them to the Security Control Post before leaving the Building.
