Guidelines on Indoor Air Temperature and Humidity

Thank you for your letter dated 23 September 2013 inviting the Institute to offer views on the captioned. We would like to offer our comments as below:

- 1. For the sake of thermal comfort, the 25.5°C and RH 70% quoted in paragraph 3.5 is not desirable. Comfort zone of the relevant standard, e.g. ASHRAE, should be complied with;
- The parameters should be reviewed for different usage of premises, e.g. theatre, classroom, office, restaurant, gymnasium, bedroom, living room, etc. One set of condition, i.e. 25.5°C and RH 70% is not sufficient to cope with different operating scenarios; and
- A general coverage of air movement, which is the prime objective of good IAQ, is suggested in bid to emphasize a good circulation of conditioned air to achieve the optimal thermal comfort.
